## THE BIG IDEA

Christians have a peculiar identity that starts with grace, is grounded in reality, and is defined by God's word.

## **OPENING**

- If someone asked, "Who are you?', how would you respond?
- If the various ways we define ourselves are like the layers in an onion, which layer do you tend to default to? (the sermon mentioned family, race/ethnicity, nationality, desires, job, groups, and ideals).

## **DIGGING DEEPER**

- Theologian Marva Dawn defines God's grace this way: "God's overflowing, flowing, infinitely wise love, freely given, though undeserved served and never repayable."<sup>1</sup> With this definition in mind, read 1 Corinthians 15:15. How did grace define Paul's identity?
- How can we develop "sober judgment" about ourselves?
- The sermon suggested that the "deadly sins" often intoxicate us, resulting in us not being "sober" in our judgment about ourselves. Which of the following "deadly sins" is the most challenging?<sup>2</sup>

Pride: Intoxicated by self-importance
