3 Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has said, "So I declared on oath in my anger, 'They shall never enter my rest." And yet his works have been finished since the creation of the world.







4 For somewhere he has spoken about the seventh day in these words: "On the seventh day God rested from all his works. 5 And again in the passage above he says, "They shall never enter my rest."









6 Therefore since it still remains for some to enter that rest, and since those who formerly had the good news proclaimed to them did not go in because of their disobedience,





7 God again set a certain day, calling it "Today." This he did when a long time later he spoke through David, as in the passage already quoted: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts."





EWS 4: 8-10

8 For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not have spoken later about another day. 9 There remains, then, a Sabbath rest for the people of God; 10 for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from their works, just as God did from his.





11 Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will perish by following their example of disobedience.

for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. Today, if only you would hear his voice, 8 "Do not harden your hearts as you did at Meribah,(quarreling) as you did that day at Massah (testing) in the wilderness,

2 By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work.





HEBREWS 4:4







8 Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.







9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns.





11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.









Then he (Jesus) said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.



The Sabbath is a command to stop and rest. It is an invitation to worship the Creator. Ultimately, it is the revelation of your identity as a child of God where the Lord delights in your uniqueness and transforms

you.


